2.1 Supplementary Table 1S: Variable List

Variable
Symptoms (one variable each): pain, tremors, sweating, paleness, nausea, vomiting, sialorrhea, abdominal pain, irritability, drowsiness, cold extremities, tachypnea, bradycardia, tachycardia, dyspnea, rales, low oxygen saturation, hypotension, hypertension, circulatory shock, altered mental status, convulsion, fever, arrhythmias, cardiopulmonary arrest, acute lung edema, infection.
Laboratory findings (one variable each): capillary blood glucose, venous blood glucose, leukocytes, erythrocytes, platelets, sodium, potassium, bicarbonate, amylase, pH, lactate, troponin, total CK,
Imaging: Cardiac dysfunction on echocardiogram.
Primary outcome: Intensive care unit transfer
Secondary outcomes (one variable each): intubation, death, sequelae.

A total of 46 variables were included in this analysis, after duplicate variables were discarded.
